- Clinical Research Physician (Cardiologist or Epidemiologist with Cardiology focus)

Who does this role report to?

- The candidate will join the Medical Department at Cardialysis reporting to the Medical Director.

What is the pay range of this position?

- To be provided during the interview process. The salary is competitive and based on 1) training (MD, MSc, PhD), 2) years of experience in medicine, 3) years of experience in clinical research, 4) track record in clinical research

What activities are performed within this position?

- The Clinical Research Physician is involved in trial design and protocol development, medical monitor and safety reporting (pharmacovigilance), clinical trial oversight, trial reporting, core lab activities, endpoint adjudication, data and safety monitoring boards, statistical interpretation, congress participation for abstract presentations.

Which training / education is required for this position?

- Medical Doctor with cardiology training or a PhD in a field related to cardiology or epidemiology training with focus on cardiology. Cardialysis focuses on interventional cardiology for which advanced understanding of the specialty is required.
- Research experience with a track-record in peer-reviewed journals.
- Excellent communication skills (i.e. English fluency, speaking and writing)
